CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of SIMPSON CREEK, tributary to COQUILLE RIVER for FROST CONTROL AND CRANBERRY HARVESTING ON 9.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 31757. The date of priority is JULY 11, 1966. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.0 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs), being 0.1 cfs for frost control and 0.9 cfs for cranberry harvesting, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

28 S	14 W	WM	20	SE NW	2100 FEET SOUTH & 250 FEET WEST FROM N1/4 CORNER, SECTION 20

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 28, 1997, at Special Order Volume 51, Page 145, approving Transfer Application 6698, and supersedes Certificate 35820, State record of Water Right Certificates.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
