CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ALTON W & WILMA A LEMBKE

JACKSONVILLE OR 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of APPELGATE LAKE RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-7810, tributary to APPELGATE RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 1.25 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 46689. The date of priority is DECEMBER 18, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.0 ACRE FEET STORED WATER ONLY, if available at the original point of diversion, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein. This right is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract No. 2-07-10-W0448; or a satisfactory replacement, between the Bureau of Reclamation and the water user, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:


**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 15, 1996, at Special Order Volume 50, Page 358, approving Transfer Application 7249, and together with Certificate 72294, supersedes Certificate 65029, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
