CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

OWEN L AND MARYLYN R GOSSETT  
11691 AGATE RD  
EAGLE POINT OR 97524

confirms the right to use the waters of UNNAMED STREAM AND GOSSETT RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-6399, tributaries to ROGUE RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 2.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 39940. The date of priority is AUGUST 29, 1975. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.035 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage. The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 8, 1992, at Special Order Volume 46, Page 190, approving Transfer Application 6652, and supersedes Certificate 61680, State record of Water Right Certificates.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
