 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MITCHELL SCHOOL DISTRICT 55

confirms the right to use the waters of BRIDGE CREEK, tributary to JOHN DAY RIVER for IRRIGATION of 2.8 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wheeler County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12, at Page 388. The date of priority is 1896.

The use is limited to ONE-FORTIETH OF ONE CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND PER ACRE OF LAND IRRIGATED BEFORE JUNE 15, AND ONE-EIGHTIETH OF ONE CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND PER ACRE AFTER JUNE 15, DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON FROM MARCH 1 TO OCTOBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted, under this water right, at the other diversions, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion, located as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 26, 1993, at Special Order Volume 47, Page 324, approving Transfer Application 6545, and together with Certificate 68324, supersedes Certificate 13579, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
