 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN E. GRIBBLE
 EUGENE OR 97401

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary to BEAR CREEK for IRRIGATION of 13.35 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 1.65 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-5018. The date of priority is DECEMBER 13, 1920. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of June 28, 1932, or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plans and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with section 5728, Oregon Laws.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 9469, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEP 29 2010, approving Transfer Application T-9616 and a partial diminution of Certificate 9469.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
