 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the MALHEUR LAKE BASIN for IRRIGATION of 62.26 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10106. The date of priority is MAY 26, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.78 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

25 S	30 E	WM	36	SE NE	1320 FEET SOUTH AND 1350 FEET WEST FROM N1/4 CORNER, SECTION 36

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works shall include an airline and pressure gauge or an access port for a measuring line adequate to determine the water level elevation in the well at all times.

The water user shall maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 82605, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCT 08 2010, approving Transfer Application T-11079 for a change in place of use and an additional point of appropriation.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
