 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FRED T OWEN
 10 SOUTH FOOTHILL RD
 MEDFORD OR 97504

confirms the right to use the waters of HUMBUG CREEK, tributary to BIG APPLGATE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 21.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 22380. The date of priority is APRIL 29, 1953. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.26 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND if available at the original point of diversion, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion, being located as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 6, 1991, at Special Order Volume 45, Page 483, approving Transfer Application 6452, and supersedes Certificate 45758, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
