 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

A. S. KLEINHAMMER
 BUNCOM, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of the LITTLE APPLGATE RIVER, a tributary to the APPLGATE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 93.6 ACRES, DOMESTIC and STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 1, 1857, for 1.80 cfs for irrigation of 71.6 acres; 1898 for 0.55 cfs for irrigation of 22 acres, domestic, and stock use. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.35 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:



The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
