CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RUSSELL UNDERWOOD
8756 SPRINGHILL DR
ALBANY OR 97321

confirms the right to use the waters of FIVE WELLS, in the WILLAMETTE RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 138.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11181. The date of priority is MAY 31, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.73 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, if available at the original wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original points of appropriation.

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.


The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 10, 1997, at Special Order Volume 51, Page 17, approving Transfer Application 7270, and supersedes Certificate 68626, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
