CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICHARD D IRISH
2567 E EVANS CREEK RD
ROGUE RIVER OR 97537

confirms the right to use the waters of EVANS CREEK, tributary to ROGUE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 16.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 1173. The date of priority is APRIL 10, 1912. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.20 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the authorized point of diversion, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
36 S	4 W	WM	4	NW SE	1180 FEET SOUTH & 2070 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 4

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

36 S	4 W	WM	4	NW SE	2508 FEET NORTH & 2409 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 4

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 27, 1997, at Special Order Volume 51, Page 262, approving Transfer Application 7101, and together with Certificate 74155, supersedes Certificate 2015, State record of Water Right Certificates.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
