### CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

### CROCKER FARMS 27118 HUBBARD ROAD MONROE OR 97456

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 2 AND WELL 1, within the LONG TOM RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 67.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-2591. The date of priority is JANUARY 15, 1964. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.38 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original well, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The new well shall take water only from the same aquifer as that of original well.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director originally entered June 10, 1996, at Special Order Volume 50, Page 315, approving Transfer Application 6880, and superseded by an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 27, 2010, at Special Order Volume 82, Page 1191, and together with Certificate 72375, supersedes Certificate 38200, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
