CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

G.T. MEADOR

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 8.1 ACRES, LIVESTOCK AND DOMESTIC.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 10, at Page 365. The date of priority is 1867.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to Sept. 30; further limited to one acre-foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and $\frac{3}{4}$ acre foot per acre thereafter; total 5.0 acre-feet per acre for season, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 25550, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered approving Transfer Application T-10987 for an additional point of diversion.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
