 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of UMATILLA RIVER, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 15.59 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 1234. The date of priority is JUNE 14, 1912. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.19 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
2 N	33 E	WM	7	NE NW	SOUTH 20 DEGREES 15 MINUTES WEST, 1312.3 FEET FROM N¼ CORNER, SECTION 7

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion, located as follows:

2 N	33 E	WM	6	SW SE	NORTH 75 DEGREES EAST, 120 FEET FROM S¼ CORNER, SECTION 6

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 5, 1994, at Special Order Volume 48, Page 229, approving Transfer Application 6953, and together with Certificate 68390, supersedes Certificate 1320, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
