## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH FORK OF LITTLE BUTTE CREEK, a tributary to LITTLE BUTTE CREEK for IRRIGATION of 9.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 14, at Page 498. The date of priority is MAY 12, 1896. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.225 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, MEASURED AT THE HEAD OF THE DITCH OR THE POINT WHERE THE SAME LEAVES THE NATURAL STREAM, FROM APRIL 1<sup>ST</sup> TO OCTOBER 1<sup>ST</sup> OF EACH YEAR.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
