CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of MUDDY CREEK, tributary to MARY'S RIVER for WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT.

This right was perfected under Permit S-21027. The date of priority is DECEMBER 26, 1951. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.29 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion; being further limited to a total annual volume of 64.46 acre-feet.

Period of use is limited to the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The water user shall maintain an in-line totalizing flow meter, capable of displaying instantaneous flow, for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Any pond or wetland area supplied under this right shall be constructed and maintained in a manner so as not to appropriate other public waters.

The water user shall maintain and operate a fish screening and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION, PLACE OF USE, and CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 20, 2007, at Special Order Volume 73, Page 826, approving Transfer Application T-10173, and supercedes Certificate 27247, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described,
