CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

OREGON GOLF ASSOCIATION 8364 SW NIMBUS AVE BEAVERTON OR 97005

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH WELL, WEST WELL, AND SOUTH WELL, tributaries to MILL CREEK BASIN (PUDDING RIVER) for IRRIGATION of 78.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-1880. The date of priority is JUNE 9, 1961. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.85 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original well, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The type and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in USE, PLACE OF USE, AND POINTS OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 30, 1995, at Special Order Volume 49, Page 140, approving Transfer Application 7013, and together with Certificate 68451, supersedes Certificate 33642, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
