## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICHARD L. AND SANDRA M. TWIGG dba TWIGG FARM 31500 SW FIRDALE RD CORNELIUS OR 97113

confirms the right to use the waters of A RESERVOIR, constructed under Permit R-1932, a tributary of the TUALATIN RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 8.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 24482. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 26, 1956. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 10.0 ACRE FEET, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 10.0 acre feet per year for all rights perfected under Permit 24482.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
