confirms the right to use the waters of SECOND CREEK, tributary to CHETCO RIVER for QUASI-MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-35534. The date of priority is AUGUST 18, 1970. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The use of water under this right is limited to an annual volume of 17.86 acre-feet per year.

The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement device and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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The Director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring devices at each point of diversion. If the Director notifies the water user to install totalizing flow meters or other measuring devices, the water user shall install such devices specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order and shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in CHARACTER OF USE AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 19, 2010, at Special Order Volume 80, Page 1035, approving Transfer Application T-10880, and supercedes Certificate 85340, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
