CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

NORTHWEST FARM CREDIT SERVICES, FLCA PO BOX 878 PENDLETON OR 97801

confirms the right to use the waters of COLUMBIA RIVER, tributary to PACIFIC OCEAN for IRRIGATION of 160 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-35003. The date of priority is MARCH 12, 1970. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The total quantity of water diverted at both diversion points for lands described as tract 2 under this right and Certificates 86750, 86752, 86753 and 86754 shall not exceed 7.8 cubic feet per second.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 24, 1991, at Special Order Volume 45, Page 412, approving Transfer Application 6496, and supersedes Certificate 51769, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
