confirms the right to use the waters of DESCHUTES RIVER, tributary to the Columbia River for DOMESTIC EXPANDED FOR 7 HOUSEHOLDS, IRRIGATION OF UP TO ONE HALF ACRE LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDENS FOR 9 HOUSEHOLDS, AND IRRIGATION of 1.66 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-50237. The date of priority is OCTOBER 29, 1987. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.18 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.03 FOR DOMESTIC EXPANDED FOR 7 HOUSEHOLDS, 0.11 CFS FOR IRRIGATION OF UP TO ONE HALF ACRE LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDENS FOR 9 HOUSEHOLDS (SERVED BY DOMESTIC USE UNDER CERTIFICATE 27497), AND 0.04 CFS FOR IRRIGATION of 1.66 ACRES or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.


