CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

W.P. FARLOW
LAKE CREEK, OR 97524

confirms the right to use the waters of the SOUTH FORK OF LITTLE BUTTE CREEK, a tributary to LITTLE BUTTE CREEK for IRRIGATION OF 12.5 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 14, at Page 498. The date of priority is MAY 1, 1900.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.29 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, measured at the head of the ditch or the point where the same leaves the natural stream, from April 1 to October 1 of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 17177, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered DEC 28 2010, approving Transfer Application T-11128.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
