## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT.

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

F EUGENE STOCKHOFF 1301 FULTON ST NO. 150 NEWBERG OR 97132

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 1, WELL 2, WELL 3, AND WELL 4, tributaries to LAMBERT SLOUGH (WILLAMETTE RIVER) BASIN for IRRIGATION of 252.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-3392. The date of priority is AUGUST 5, 1966. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed a total of 2.38 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS) in any combination from the wells, if available at the original wells (Wells 1 & 2), being no more than 1.27 CFS from Well 1, 1.11 CFS from Well 2, 0.72 CFS from Well 3, and 0.72 CFS from Well 4, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. If in any subsequent proceedings it is determined that the source of water herein described is that claimed in Ground Water Registration Certificate numbered GR-58 and the right claimed in the registration certificate is confirmed, that part of the right herein confirmed shall be of no force or effect.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (wells), together with that diverted at the old point of appropriations, shall not exceed the quantity lawfully available from the original points of appropriation, Wells 1 & 2.

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in ADDITIONAL POINTS OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 27, 1996, at Special Order Volume 50, Page 160, approving Transfer Application 6666, and supersedes Certificate 42144, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
