CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MADELON PETROFF LIVING TRUST VICTOR PETROFF, TRUSTEE 1000 SW BROADWAY STE 1010 PORTLAND OR 97205

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS, tributary to LABISH DRAINAGE DITCH for IRRIGATION of 50.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4041. The date of priority is MARCH 26, 1968. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.62 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 16, 1996, at Special Order Volume 50, Page 51, approving Transfer Application 7010, and together with Certificate 68755, supersedes Certificate 43194, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.
