 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL within the JOHNSON CREEK BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION on 18.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit U-611. The date of priority is MARCH 12, 1954. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.39 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

6 N	35 E	WM	29	NW NW	780 FEET SOUTH AND 1025 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 29

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 ACRE-FEET per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows: The West 90 rods of the N½ NW¼ of Section 29. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm an HISTORIC CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered **JAN 18 2011**, approving Transfer Application T-11034, and together with Certificate 86795, supersedes Certificate 26521, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
