CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN AND DOROTHY RANDALL
42866 NEW BRIDGE RD
RICHLAND OR 97870

confirms the right to use the waters of EAGLE CREEK, tributary to POWDER RIVER for IRRIGATION of 8.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1888.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

9 S	45 E	WM	10	SE NW	KAY YOUNG DITCH: 1700 FEET SOUTH AND 2450 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 10

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Within two years after the date of this Certificate, the water user shall install a fish screening and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the new point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) design and construction standards. Prior to installation, the water user shall obtain written approval from ODFW that the required screen and/or by-pass device meets ODFW's criteria. The water user may withdraw water at the new point of diversion without screening or by-pass devices until two years after the date of this order. The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards.

This certificate is issued to confirm an HISTORIC CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered **JAN 24 2011**, approving Transfer Application T-11100, and together with Certificate 86797, supersedes Certificate 44243, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
