## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HIRAM G. OLSEN 8930 SUVER ROAD MONMOUTH, OR 97361

confirms the right to use the waters of the LUCKIAMUTE RIVER, a tributary to the WILLAMETTE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 548.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-52679. The date of priority is AUGUST 19, 1993. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 5.39 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

Period of Use: March 1 through July 31 for live flow from the Luckiamute River; March 1 through October 31 for stored water or as may be further limited by the Bureau of Reclamation Water Supply Contract.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order, shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the water user to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the right.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screening and by-pass devices as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversions.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
