 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE F. WERST AND HUGH DOUGHERTY
 WALLOWA OR 97885

confirms the right to use the waters of WALLOWA RIVER, tributary to GRANDE RONDE RIVER, for IRRIGATION AND DOMESTIC of 67.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-7637. The date of priority is JULY 16, 1926. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.93 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q
1 N	42 E	WM	11	SW NW

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 9125, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JAN 28 2011, approving Transfer Application T-7742, and together with Certificate 86809 supersedes Certificate 9125.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
