This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ANN WISNOVSKY 1352 APPLEGATE ROAD JACKSONVILLE, OREGON 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of the LITTLE APPLEGATE RIVER, a tributary of the APPLEGATE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 24.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-36586. The date of priority is OCTOBER 27, 1971. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.31 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION: FARMER'S DITCH LOCATED IN THE NE'4 NE'4, SECTION 14, T 39 S, R 3 W, W.M.; ORIGINAL COORDINATES: 210 FEET SOUTH AND 970 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER OF SECTION 14; ALSO LOCATED AS GPS COORDINATES: LATITUDE 42.18400, LONGITUDE -123.0174) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

ADDITIONAL POD: SW¼ SE¼, SECTION 33, T 38 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 300 FEET NORTH AND 1520 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 33.

FARMER'S DITCH: NE¼ NE¼, SECTION 14, T 39 S, R 3 W, W.M.; ORIGINAL COORDINATES: 210 FEET SOUTH AND 970 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 14; ALSO LOCATED AS GPS COORDINATES: LATITUDE 42.18400, LONGITUDE -123.0174.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.50 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available simultaneously at the original point of diversion.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen device at the new point of diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 3, 2006, approving Transfer Application 9669, and supersedes Certificate 80990, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
