confirms the right to use the waters of EAST BIRCH CREEK, a tributary of BIRCH CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 4.2 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at Page 127. The dates of priority are 1873 for 0.85 acre, 1882 for 2.12 acres and 1895 for 1.23 acres.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 0.052 cubic foot per second, subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error in describing the breakdown of the number of acres per each priority date described on Certificate 82676. This Certificate supersedes Certificate 82676, and together with Certificates 86836, 86837, 86838 and 86839 describes the portion of water right Certificate 47434, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 6, 2006, and recorded at Volume 70, Page 704, approving Transfer Application T-9493.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above described purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
