 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KATHY DEAN  
 71 YALE CREEK ROAD  
 JACKSONVILLE, OR 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of YALE CREEK, or RIGHT FORK OF THE LITTLE APPEGATE RIVER, a tributary of the APPEGATE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 58.24 ACRES AND DEVELOPMENT OF 4 HORSEPOWER.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1865 FOR 0.67 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) FOR IRRIGATION OF 26.74 ACRES; 1880 FOR 0.63 CFS FOR IRRIGATION OF 25 ACRES; 1907 FOR 0.16 CFS FOR IRRIGATION OF 6.5 ACRES; AND DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE; AND 1907 FOR 0.15 CFS FOR FARM POWER WHEEL.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.61 CFS.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

This certificate corrects scrivener's errors in the number of acres and cfs in Certificate 80378 and in the location of points of diversion in Certificate 43583. This certificate supersedes Certificates 80378, 79634 and 43583 and describes the portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 43583, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of the orders of the Water Resources Director entered September 18, 2002 approving Transfer Application T-8892, and July 24, 2003 approving Transfer Application T-8765.


The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within 60 days of the date of service.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
