CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

A. E. GILKISON
NORTH POWDER, OR 97867

confirms the right to use the waters of WOLF CREEK, a tributary to POWDER RIVER for IRRIGATION of 8.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1872.

The amount of water used for irrigation is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 4170, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 18, 2009, and recorded at Special Order Volume 77, pages 788 to 796, approving a change in point of diversion and partial cancellation of a water right under Transfer Application T-7503.

This certificate corrects a scrivener error in the certificate recorded at page 85227, State Record of Water Right Certificates. Certificate 85227, describing the remaining portions of the water right not affected by Transfer Application T-7503, erroneously listed 6.5 acres of April 1872 priority modified by the order approving the transfer. This certificate supersedes Certificate 85227, and together with Certificate 86876 supersedes Certificate 4170.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
