CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of: WASTE WATER, a tributary of the Walla Walla River for the purpose of SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 8.0 acres confirmed under Permit S-5437. The date of priority is April 24, 1922.

The amount of water to which such right is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate confirms an order of the Water Resources Director entered on 8/14/12, and recorded in Special Order Volume 96, Page 319 approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate evidences the diminution of a portion of Certificate 5084 and along with Certificate 86899 supersedes Certificate 5084.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
