CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of: WASTE WATER, a tributary of WALLA WALLA WATERSHED for the purpose of SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 8.6 acres. This right was perfected under Permit S-6044. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 24, 1923.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate confirms an order of the Water Resources Director entered on 8/14/12, and recorded in Special Order Volume 98, Page 371 approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate evidences a diminution and supersedes Certificates 5576.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
