CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of WASTE WATER from N 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 3, Township 5 North, Range 35 East, W.M., a tributary of the Walla Walla River , for the purpose of SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION FOR 4.2 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit S-12905. The date of priority is JULY 8, 1937. The right is limited to not more than 0.15 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-THIRTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to divert water from the stream from which the waste water is diverted nor the right to require the wasteful use of water by others; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and the right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained herein.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate confirms an order of the Water Resources Director entered on 8/14/12, and recorded in Special Order Volume 28, Page 31A approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district.
