## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That EMMA VORUZ of Baker, Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well, located in the SEAST of Section 2, Township 9 South, Range 40 East, Willamette Meridian on the Powder River Watershed for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. U-13 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 24, 1929; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.05 cubic feet per second.

The point of diversion is located in the  $SE_2^1SW_2^1$  of Section 2, Township 9 South, Range 40 East, W.M.

The use hereunder shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant is as follows: 14 acres in the SE<sub>2</sub>SW<sub>2</sub>, 30 acres in the NE<sub>2</sub>SW<sub>2</sub> and 40 acres in the SE<sub>2</sub>NW<sub>2</sub>, <u>Section 2</u>, Township 9 South, Range 40 Bast, Willamette Meridian in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for any purpose is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
