CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CORA E. JONES  
MILTON-FREEWATER, OR 97862

confirms the right to use the waters of the Walla Walla River, a tributary of the Columbia River, for the purpose of IRRIGATION of 1.11 acres.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 12, Page 9. The date of priority is 1885.

The use is limited to 1.5 miner's inches per acre, or 0.04 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and the right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the above described decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 12988, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 14 2012, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes a portion of Certificate 12988.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
