CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use WASTE OR SURPLUS WATERS from the Milton Ditch, Finis Ditch, Powell Ditch, and irrigation wells, tributaries of the Walla Walla River, for the purpose of IRRIGATION of 15.20 ACRES. The right was perfected under Permit S-5989 of the State Engineer. The date of priority is AUGUST 4, 1923.

The use is limited to 0.19 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
