 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the McELRATH WELL, within the Walla Walla Basin, for the purpose of SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION FOR 15.0 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit G-1682. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 9, 1960. The right is limited to not more than 0.15 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The well is located as follows:

6N	35E	WM	33	NE SE	9 CHAINS SOUTH AND 13 CHAINS WEST FROM THE EAST ¼ CORNER OF SECTION 33

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 ACRE FEET PER ACRE for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate confirms an order of the Water Resources Director entered on 8/14/12, and recorded in Special Order Volume 88, Page 319 approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes Certificate 31209.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
