CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM R EICHER

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLIAMS CREEK, tributary to APPLGATE RIVER for IRRIGATION, STORAGE of 13.47 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit E-188. The date of priority is JULY 15, 1913. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.17 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
38 S	5 W	WM	26	NE SW	763 FEET SOUTH & 1838 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 26

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion described as follows:

38 S	5 W	WM	35	SW SW	DIXON SPARLIN DITCH: 680 FEET NORTH & 200 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 35

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water the water user is entitled. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 1, 1983, at Special Order Volume 37, Page 530, approving Transfer Application 5336, and together with Certificate 51859, supersedes Certificate 45514, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
