CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BEN INMAN

JUNCTION CITY OR 97448

confirms the right to use the waters of FERN RIDGE RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION R-29397, PERMIT R-1625, a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 26.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 26089. The date of priority is MARCH 26, 1959. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 55.9 ACRE FEET STORED WATER ONLY, if available at the authorized point of diversion, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 55.9 acre feet. Per year, and this right is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract No. 8-07-10-W1187 dated December 12, 1997.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 9, 1998, at Special Order Volume 52, Page 166, approving Transfer Application 7752, and together with Certificate 75139, supersedes Certificate 30983, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
