CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

OREGON DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE
74135 RIVERVIEW LANE
IRRIGON OR 97844

confirms the right to use the waters of THREE HORIZONTAL WATER INFILTRATION SYSTEMS, in the COLUMBIA RIVER BASIN for REARING FISH FROM EGG TO RELEASE SIZE (FISH CULTURE).

This right was perfected under Permit G-10142. The date of priority is MAY 2, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 55.75 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND from any one or combination of the authorized points of diversion, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (Infiltration System 3), together with the quantity diverted at the old points of appropriation (Infiltration Systems 1 and 2), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original points of appropriation.

When required by the Department the water user shall install in-line flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 25, 1998, at Special Order Volume 52, Page 256, approving Transfer Application 7832, and supersedes Certificate 65410, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
