 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-1932, tributaries of the TUALATIN RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 24.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-49702. The date of priority is MAY 12, 1986. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 135 GALLONS PER MINUTE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-1932, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer, provided further water shall not be appropriated during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year except for stored water.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 68504, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered **APR 25 2011**, approving Transfer Application T-11176.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
