CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BENJAMIN AND ASHLEY JOHNSTON
9460 SUNNYVIEW RD NE
SALEM OR 97301

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, tributary to PUDDING RIVER for IRRIGATION of 3.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4410. The date of priority is November 18, 1968. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, shall not exceed 0.04 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation, further limited to a total annual volume not to exceed 4.0 acre feet (being 1.25 acre feet per acre), during the irrigation season (March 1 through October 31) of each year.

The new point of appropriation is located as follows:

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

Ground water production in the well shall be limited to a single aquifer within equivalent water-bearing zones encountered in MARI 7667.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain and operate an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION; PLACE OF USE, AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 18, 2008, at Special Order Volume 75, Page 574, approving Transfer Application 10584, and supersedes Certificate 42223, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
