## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ABBEY FARM LLC 7365 MERIDIAN ROAD NE SILVERTON, OREGON 97381

confirms the right to use the waters of Abiqua Creek, a tributary of Pudding River, for IRRIGATION of 44.0 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit S40232. The date of priority is February 19, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.55 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 ½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error in the name of the water right holder described on Certificate 82968. This Certificate supersedes Certificate 82968, and describes the portion of water right Certificate 50849, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 12, 2007, and recorded at Volume 71, Pages 163-166, approving Transfer Application T-10226.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
