confirms the right to use the waters of GULCH and SPRING near CENTER LINE of SECTION 10, a tributary of INDIAN CREEK, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 4.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Hood River County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 200. The date of priority is 1907.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.048 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
