This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Hood River County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 200. The date of priority is APRIL 11, 1908.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially for said purposes, and shall not exceed ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, and that the total quantity diverted during the irrigation season shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre, measured at the point of diversion. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
