CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHAS. L. LOW  
PLEASANT VALLEY OR 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of ALDER CREEK and HILL CREEK, tributaries to BURNT RIVER for IRRIGATION of 14.5 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8, at Page 134. The date of priority is 1863 FOR 0.5 ACRE, 1868 FOR 1.0 ACRE AND 1864 FOR 13.0 ACRES.

The amount of water used for irrigation is limited to a diversion of shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, with the further limitations contained in paragraph 64 of said decree. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


