confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 5 AND WELL 9 in the Columbia River Basin for MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5594. The date of priority is AUGUST 1, 1972. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.20 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS) in any combination, being 1.62 CFS from Well 5 and 2.20 CFS from Well 9, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The combined quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (Well 9), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation (Well 5), shall not exceed the maximum rate and duty allowed under this right.

The wells are located as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

The water user shall maintain the meters or other suitable measuring devices in good working order.

The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the wells at all times.

Water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.
