CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

NEAL & ANNA DOW
28000 SE PAULINA HWY
PRINEVILLE, OR 97754

confirms the right to use the waters of the CROOKED RIVER, a tributary to the DESCHUTES RIVER for IRRIGATION of 46.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-9562. The date of priority is MARCH 17, 1930. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.58 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original points of diversion, being:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain and operate a headgate to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 86197, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered _____, approving Transfer Application T-11150 approving a change for an additional point of diversion. **AUG 08 2011**

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
