CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

NEAL & ANNA DOW  
28000 SE PAULINA HWY  
PRINEVILLE, OR 97754

confirms the right to use the waters of the CROOKED RIVER, a tributary to the DESCHUTES RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 26.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-42025. The date of priority is JANUARY 2, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.67 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original points of diversion, being:

16 S	19 E	WM	30	SE NE	2700 FEET NORTH AND 2200 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 19

When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain and operate a headgate to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 86200, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 0 0 2011, approving Transfer Application T-11150 approving a change for an additional point of diversion.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
